

# Videographer Brief

## Youth Led Change Day

### About the event

The Youth Led Change Day is a national event that happens every year that bring together **18–30-year-olds who are at a stage in their development where they are creating their own social change and have received funding to support this**. In 2026, the event is taking place in Birmingham at **10am – 5pm on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> April**.

The Youth Led Change Day brings young changemakers and lived experience leaders working across different issue areas together from across England to build new connections, develop their skills, and celebrate the amazing work they do.

**The theme this year is: The Future is Ours.**

### Purpose

We want to work alongside a film-maker / videographer at our upcoming Youth Led Change Day on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> April to produce a short film that captures the essence of the day.

### Audience

This will support Blagrove in articulating the importance of the event and youth led change more broadly to other funders, the wider sector, and potential future changemakers. It will also be a chance to spotlight changemakers on the day.

### Output

A 2–4 minute landscape video that Blagrove can share on social media and upload to our website. This will be mainly interviews with attendees as well as supplementary footage that will all be filmed at the event.

We want the final output to address the below questions:

- What change are you making in the world?
- What would your alternative future look like?
- How would this future centre joy and hope?

## Access to people and information

The videographer will have their own room for filming at our Youth Led Change Day where they can interview partners throughout the day. They will also have full access to the main delivery rooms to film as appropriate.

## What we are looking for

We expect the ideal candidate to be someone who:

- Is a people-person: can quickly build rapport and mutual understanding with attendees.
- Respectful of partners: respecting their needs, checking consent, and being sensitive to what is shared regarding their own stories.
- A track record of producing inspiring similar work
- Skilled in the creative direction, production, filming and editing of videos.

## Key dates

- Deadline for proposals: Monday 9<sup>th</sup> February
- Briefing call: w/c 23<sup>rd</sup> February
- Youth Led Change Day: 11<sup>th</sup> April
- Final output: Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April.

## Budget

Our day rate for videographers is £660/day (excluding VAT) and we expect you to have your own equipment. We are open to hearing from you how many days you anticipate this project to take.

The time anticipated will need to cover:

- Briefing calls and planning
- Filming, producing and directing at the event itself
- Editing and any other necessary post-production

We will cover your travel and food for the Youth Led Change Day and have booked a dedicated room for filming at the venue.

## Safeguarding

The successful applicant will be required to undertake a basic DBS check, as per our [safer recruitment policy](#). Our intention is not to discriminate but to ensure the safety of all those involved. The successful applicant will also be expected to comply with Blagrove's [safeguarding policy](#) and processes at all times, receiving training on our procedure from our Designated Safeguarding Lead.
